PADS Volunteers Urgently Needed

PADS (Public Action to Deliver Shelter) provides winter shelter and support to the homeless in our Kendall County area from mid October to mid April. It takes 600 volunteers to accomplish this 7 days/ week. This year we are still short of that number and looking for volunteers to offer **4 1/2 hours per month** to help in this cause. Volunteers are given a handbook and work with experienced volunteers.

Hours are:

- Shift I 6:30 PM to 11:00 PM. Set up the site; guest registrations; visit with guests
- Shift II 10:45 PM to 3:00 AM. Watch over sleeping guests; make lunches
- Shift III 2:45 AM to 7:30 AM Wake up and serve breakfast for guests; clean up site
